

AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION

between

Institution **Pan-European University
Faculty of Psychology**
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and

Institution **National Academy of Educational Science of Ukraine
Institut of the Gifted Child (IOD)**
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Pan-European University in Bratislava, Slovak Republic, represented by Dean of the Faculty of Psychology Eva Naništová (hereinafter referred to as the first signatory) and Institute of the Gifted Child of the National Academy of Educational Sciences of Ukraine, Kyiv, Ukraine, represented by Director Maksym S. Galchenko, (hereinafter referred to as second signatory), (hereinafter referred to as the signatories) have concluded the following agreement in the field of education and scientific research:

Article 1

The subject of this agreement is mutual cooperation in the field of education and scientific research, as agents of development, understanding among nations and permanent international cooperation.

Article 2

The signatories agree in the framework of their goals and tasks they shall cooperate abiding to the legislation in force in the states of both signatories and to the rules and criteria of the institutions of both signatories of the agreement.

Article 3

The cooperation shall be based on and supported by the initiatives of mutual interest of both signatories, namely on:

- a) exchange of experience in the area of education and of scientific research work;

- b) collaboration in the development of new study programmes and performance of common scientific research and professional projects;
- c) potential of collaboration in publishing joint publications, textbooks, as well as on collaboration regarding existing and new publications;
- d) organisation of meetings, symposia, seminars, discussions, and other scientific and professional events on topics interesting for both signatories of the agreement; and
- e) support to education through exchange of higher education teachers, scientific researchers, and students.

Article 4

Organizational, financial and other issues related to all forms of cooperation under this agreement shall be governed by a programme on cooperation between the members, annex to this agreement or by other appropriate means.

Article 5

The signatories agree that for the realisation of individual activities referred to in article 3 of this agreement they will endeavour to procure funding and provide for other forms of involvement of state, scientific, business and other organisations registered in their respective countries.

Article 6

This agreement has been concluded for indefinite time and enters into force on the day it has been signed by the authorised representatives of the two signatories.


Article 7

This agreement is drawn up in four (4) equal copies, of which each signatory shall receive two (2) copies.




